



DELTA XI (Formerly BETA TAU CHAPTER) ALABAMA STATE ORGANIZATION THE DELTA KAPPA GAMMA SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL

Chapter Rules/By-Laws

Article I: Name

The name of this chapter shall be Delta Xi Chapter, Alabama State Organization, The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.

Article II: Purposes and Mission

The purposes of Delta Xi Chapter shall be the seven purposes of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International and those of the Alabama State Organization.

The mission of Delta Xi Chapter will be the mission of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society, which promotes professional and personal growth of women educators and excellence in education.

Article III: Membership

Membership is in accordance with the Constitution, Article II and the Standing Rules, Section 3. The Chapter has full authority for the administration of membership.

- A. Delta Xi Chapter shall be unlimited in membership. It is not mandatory to have an induction each year.
- B. Forms shall be available for nominations from the membership chairman throughout the year. Forms must be filed with the Membership Chairman prior to February 1st to be screened and presented to the Membership Committee at the March meeting.
- C. The vote on candidate invitation shall be taken at the March meeting by written ballot. Invitation to membership shall be by approval of a majority of votes cast.
- D. Invitations to membership shall be mailed by the Membership Chairman.
- E. Orientation shall be conducted prior to the April meeting.
- F. Candidates shall respond to the invitation in writing to the Membership Committee.

Article IV: Finance

Financial matters are in accordance with the Constitution, Standing Rules, and Alabama State Bylaws.

- A. Changes in chapter dues shall be recommended by the Executive Board, in compliance with the most recent handbook, and approved by two-thirds of the membership in attendance.
- B. Annual chapter, state and international dues shall be collected by the Chapter Treasurer at the April meeting or before June 1.
- C. The annual budget shall be developed by the Finance Committee and presented to the Chapter Executive Board for review, modification, and adoption.
- D. The Finance Committee will audit the Treasurer's books at the end of each fiscal year.
- E. The President's pin shall be presented to the President at her initiation. The pin is a gift from the membership to the President and is paid for from the chapter's general fund and is ordered by the Treasurer.
- F. Delta Xi participates in the World Fellowship Fund. The amount of \$25.00 shall be presented in December of each year.
- G. Delta Xi awards The Nora B. Hutchens Grant-In-Aid to a deserving woman in the field of education. Funds for the Grant-In-Aid shall come from the interest on deposit, contributions, and other approved activities.
- H. The Nora B. Hutchens Grant-In-Aid and the Member Grant-In-Aid shall be \$1000 each and shall be subject to adjustment by majority of the members in attendance.
- I. If funds are available, Delta Xi will reimburse the president for travel expenses for up to \$300 for Alabama State Convention and up to \$500 for out-of-state expenses for International Convention or SE Regional Convention.

Article V: Organization

Delta Xi Chapter shall govern the conduct of its business in a manner consistent with the Constitution, Standing Rules, Alabama State Bylaws, Alabama State Standing Rules, and the Delta Xi Chapter Rules.

- A. Delta Xi Chapter Officers shall be President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Recording Secretary, and Corresponding Secretary (all elected).
- B. The Nominations Committee shall consist of a Chairman and two members.
- C. The slate of officers shall be presented at the December or January meeting by the Nominations Committee. The slate shall be voted on by a show of hands, with majority rule.
- D. The Parliamentary Advisor shall be appointed by the incoming President. She is an ex-officio member of the Executive Board and does not have a vote.
- E. The Treasurer shall be selected by the chapter Executive Board. The Treasurer may serve more than one term of office and has a vote on the Executive Board.

- F. The installation of new officers shall be held at the April meeting of the biennium.
- G. The First Vice-President shall serve as the Program Chairman.
- H. The Second Vice-President shall serve as Membership Chairman.

Article VI: Officers and Related Personnel

- A. Elected chapter officers include a president, vice president, and a secretary. A treasurer is selected by the executive board. Chapters may have an elected second vice president and corresponding secretary.
- B. Only those maintaining active membership may hold office
- C. Elections are held in even- numbered years; the procedures for elections are delineated.
- D. The two-year term of office "or until a successor is names" is delineated for each office, except that of a treasurer.
- E. Although not an officer, a parliamentarian is appointed. Collegiate and honorary members may serve as parliamentarian.

Article VII: Executive Board

- A. Members include the elected officers, the immediate past president, and such other members as designated.
- B. The parliamentarian serves without vote. If the treasurer is paid for her services, she serves without vote.
- C. The executive board meets at least twice each year, but it may meet more often.
- D. A quorum is the majority of the voting members.

Article VIII: Committees

The chapter standing committees shall be as follows: Finance, Membership/Nominations, Education Excellence, Grant-In-Aid/Scholarship, Communications/Publicity, Exhibits and Records, Fundraising, Rules and Bylaws.

- A. A committee structure or an alternate structure for doing the work of specified international committees is indicated.
- B. A method of appointing/electing special committees is identified; a nominations committee may be elected or appointed; committees are appointed by the president unless exceptions are listed.
- C. The chapter president serves as member ex officio on committees except Nominations.
- D. Provisions are made for accomplishing tasks requiring immediate attention.

Article IX: Meetings

- A. The date, place, and time of the meetings shall be set by the Executive Board and assigned committees and shall be published in the yearbook.
- B. At least four business meetings are held each year; other meetings/excursions may be scheduled.
- C. A quorum for regular meetings is designated and should be determined by the chapter.
- D. A plan for matters requiring immediate chapter action, such as an executive committee.

Article X: Areas of Activity

- A. Memorials are given in the event of the death of a member. An arrangement of twelve red roses shall be purchased for the memorial service. If there is no funeral or memorial service, a contribution shall be made to The Nora B. Hutchens Grant-In-Aid Fund and shall be paid from the general fund.
- B. Death in the immediate family of a member shall be recognized by a memorial card and a contribution to The Nora B. Hutchens Grant-In-Aid Fund.
- C. Cards and notes shall be sent to members who are ill, and cards shall be sent to members for their birthdays.
- D. The chapter president will write a history of her biennium.

Article XI: Conflict of Interest Statement

- A. The Delta Xi Chapter affirms the Conflict-of-Interest Statement, which can be found in updated bylaws on the Alabama State website, March 2013 revision.
- B. Once a year, Delta Xi Chapter will have a motion to affirm the Conflict-of-Interest Statement, get a second, and vote to pass the motion.
- C. This motion and vote will be included in the minutes by the secretary.

Article XII: Communications/Publications

- A. President approves publications; the name and number of issues are specified.
- B. Chapter may meet through electronic communication as long as all the members may simultaneously hear one another and participate during the meeting.

Article XII: Parliamentary Authority

A. A statement is included that indicates the parliamentary authority designated for the governance of the chapter in instances in which the authority is not inconsistent with the *Constitution* or other adopted Society rules

Article XIII: Amendments

- A. Amendment of chapter rules shall be recommended by the Executive Board.
- B. Members shall be notified of proposed changes by mail and a vote shall be held at the next chapter meeting. A two-thirds vote of the members in attendance shall be needed for approval to amend a rule; majority to adopt a new rule.
- C. Standing rules may be amended at any chapter meeting.

Article XIV: Dissolution

- A. Prior to dissolution, the chapter shall obtain the approval of the State Executive Board.
- B. Careful consideration shall be given to the transfer of members to other chapters, should they desire.
- C. Any remaining funds in chapter accounts shall be sent to the State Treasurer for State or International projects.
- D. The chapter's paraphernalia, the Society publications, and the chapter records shall be retained in the State Archives and made available for use.
- E. The charter must be returned to the State to be forwarded to the International Headquarters.
- F. The State Executive Board shall decide whether the Greek name shall be reused or not.
